Summer Lessons: Two Great **Options!**

This summer, I'm offering two packages for summer lessons! Both options can work around vacations. Choose the package that suits your schedule:

1) "Classic"



Essentially, it's a continuation of weekly flute lessons, a "whole flute" experience. We can work on fundamentals but also District Band audition material and other solos, duets, etc. Lessons can easily be scheduled around vacations.

Weekly 45-minute lessons: \$145/month Weekly 30-minute lessons: \$105/month

2) "Intensive"



This package is concentrated into four 60-minute lessons scheduled throughout the summer at your preference. It's an option for students who want to take summer lessons but have limited availability due to vacations and other activities. "Intensive" lessons are designed to focus on a specific goal, i.e. prepping for District Band auditions, maybe learning piccolo, or anything else the student wants to work on.

Four 60-minute lessons: \$105/month or \$210/summer session

There will be no lessons May 29 – June 5; I normally take a week off starting on Memorial Day. Summer lessons will begin on June 6 and continue until August 1. I will take the first two weeks of August off and plan to start my fall schedule in mid-August.



Composer of the Month

Meredith Willson

b. May 18, 1902
d. June 15, 1984
American flutist, composer,
conductor, musical arranger,
band leader, playwright, and



author – Meredith Willson is best known for writing the book, music, and lyrics for the Broadway musical *The Music Man* (1957). Willson was born in Mason City, IA (the inspiration for the fictional town, River City, IA, in *The Music Man*). A flute and piccolo virtuoso, Willson was a member of John Philip Sousa's band as well as the New York Philharmonic Orchestra. He was twice Oscarnominated for his film scores. He also wrote "It's Beginning to Look a Lot Like Christmas" and the University of Iowa fight song. His classical compositions include *A Suite for Flute* and *Idyllwild*.
